

Project 7

Christmas Tree Skirt



Supplies needed:

- * 45" round fabric table topper or a 45" square of yardage.
- * Jan Dressler Stencil #128 Reindeer
- * P128 Paint kit for Reindeer
- * B128 brush kit for Reindeer
- * Spray adhesive for stencil
- * DAS10 Fabric Painting Medium
- * Scissors
- * Bias tape
- * Sewing Machine or glue gun

Pre-wash your tablecloth or yardage. Iron it well to remove creases.

Spray the back of the stencil lightly with adhesive, and affix the stencil to the fabric in the desired place. Mix equal amounts of acrylic paint and Fabric Painting Medium. Apply the paint through the stencil following the directions in the package. When you are finished, heat set the prints by ironing from the back side.

Fold the tablecloth in half, then in half again. Cut the tip of the triangular shape at about three inches down from the top. Then cut through only one layer of fabric from hem to hole. Sew or glue bias seam binding over the cut edges and attach ribbon ties along the edges of the slit.
